Sub: Orders empowering in-charge of IAHTUs to supervise the functioning of 'Mahila and Sishu Desks' in all the Police Stations of the District and to integrate the Women & Child Cells with the IAHTUS of the District.

In inviting a reference to the letter No.37531 dated. 26.12.2015 of the Additional DG of Police, CID, CB, Odisha, Cuttack on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that in view of the decision taken in the Joint Review meeting held on 01.10.2015 on the issues of Integrated Anti Human Trafficking Units (IAHTU) and related matters, Government have been pleased to order the following.

1. IAHTU and Women Cell's mandate being almost similar, they may function simultaneously and the IAHTU personnel would also run the Women cell.
2. The in-charge of IAHTU of the District will supervise the functioning of Mahila and Sishu Desks in all the Police Stations in the District.
3. State Crime Branch will supervise the functioning of Mahila and Sishu Desks as well as Woman & Child Cells of the District.
