## Short-Term Consultancy Assignment for Development of Session Plans on Contextualised Life Skills Education of Tribal Adolescents

#### **Terms of Reference**

#### 1. Background:

Schedule Caste and Scheduled Tribe Research and Training Institute (SCSTRTI) in partnership with the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) isworking towards strengthening the agency of tribal adolescents to challenge harmful social norms and practices. A renewed approach of life skills education has been adopted, focussing on stimulating their 'Civic Imagination' through discourse-oriented life skills education (LSE) in their residential schools. Towards this, LSE Labs have been set up as spaces for adolescents to sharpen their observation and experimentation skills on key social issues generating inquisitiveness to trigger the art of questioning leading to a discourse (open discussion on the subject). The generation of discourse on key issues is facilitated by "Young Innovators" (colloquially called Volunteers) who are youth from tribal communities. The students (Peer Educators) use their daily and lived experiences along with modern tech equipment like computers and TV to stimulate their curiosity. Once equipped/trained on the art of questioning as a means to gain knowledge on key life skills, the peer educators then emulate these sessions in their respective hostels (residential schools for tribal adolescents).

The discourse-based pedagogy is rooted in the power of questioning, of finding answers to the "what", "why" and "how" of things that one observes in oneself, the world, the society, and societal norms around. As an illustrative example, the observation of the social norm of girls getting married at a relatively early age is questioned in the labs by putting 'why' at every step on the answers received from the group until a consensus is reached on the deep-rooted cause of gender inequality. Such a method was used very effectively in ancient Greece by philosophers like Socrates, Plato, and Aristotle and for centuries has been used as a means to discover 'knowledge'.

The pursuit of going deeper through questioning and seeking answers will organically support and nurture the life skills education of adolescents.

This methodology was run as a pilot in the LSE labs in hostels in 2023 to establish systems and understand the themes that organically emerge through open-ended discourse with tribal adolescents. Through peer-led questioning and observation (working with adolescents, and field functionaries), various topics and themes were understood as pertinent to the tribal adolescents.

There is now a need to develop a framework and an aligned set of session plans for the transaction of the discourse-based LSE.

#### 2. Objective of the Assignment

The objective of the assignment is to develop a set of session plans (a structured plan with prompts and guidance for facilitators to transact the discourse-oriented LSE sessions) with an aim of:

- i. Providing structure to the discourse-oriented LSE
- ii. Aiding the volunteers and peer educators to transact the sessions more effectively



The session plans are to be developed rooted in the context of the tribal adolescents, with a deep understanding of their unique socio-cultural context.

#### 3. Scope of Work:

The scope of work for the selected consultant would include:

- Develop a framework encompassing the themes that the session plans will be based on. This is to be developed after gaining an understanding of the common themes and issues emerged from the discourse with volunteers. A discussion with the technical team is to be carried out to establish this understanding.
- II. Develop a format for the discourse-oriented LSE sessions that are unique to this approach and easy to follow by the adolescent facilitators.
- III. Development of a set of 10 discourse-oriented session plans based on the developed framework, with one session plan addressing each theme. The session plans must be structured and formulated embodying the discourse-oriented pedagogy, providing the necessary prompts and aids for the facilitators to seamlessly direct the discourse with adolescents towards understanding the root causes of the themes and collectively developing potential solutions. The methodology mentioned in the 'background' section of asking "why" and "how" appropriately is to be incorporated suitably.

The session plans must be developed keeping the following in mind:

- i. One new session will be introduced every month, adding up to a total of 8-10 sessions in a year (accounting for exams and other breaks)
- ii. The session plans will be transacted by the volunteers to peer educators as a means of training, and further transacted by the peer educators to other hostel residents in classes 6-9 and 11
- iii. The final session plans are to be developed in Odia
